

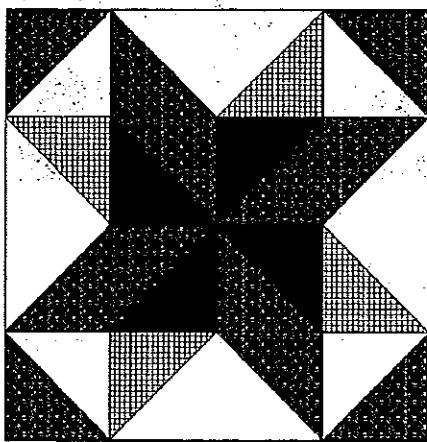
Quilter's Get - a - Way

North Bend State Park is easily accessible from U.S. 50, a four lane highway stretching west to east from Parkersburg to Clarksburg, West Virginia.

Driving EAST, take U.S. 50 to the junction of WV Route 31 to Cairo and follow the signs to the park. Driving WEST, take U.S. 50 to WV Route 16 (Harrisville) and follow the signs to the park. Consult your highway map for further details.
